



## Free Throw Shooter Information

- **No talent? No passion for basketball? No problem!**  
This isn't about basketball—it's about helping patients and their families.
- **Sigh of relief... being a Free Throw Shooter takes very little time and effort!**  
We understand your busy schedule, so Free Throws for Kids (FTFK) makes it simple.

- **At the event, your team will collectively shoot 500 free throws.**  
For example, if your team has 10 people, each member will shoot 50 free throws.
- **As a team, you need to raise at least \$1,250.**  
This may sound like a lot at first, but don't stress—last year, the average team raised \$1,770! With 10 people on your team, that's just \$125 per person. If your team isn't full yet, help your Team Captain by asking friends, family, or neighbors to join. You'll be amazed by the generosity and support for our mission.
- **FTFK provides a team website** where people can make donations directly to you and your team online. We've made it **VERY simple and easy!**
- **You also have the option to receive an individual fundraising packet.**  
This includes donation letters, cards, and envelopes that you can mail to friends, family, and others to start raising money.
- **All donation cards and checks are mailed directly to FTFK.**  
You won't have to handle collecting donations yourself.
- **FTFK will email weekly updates** (once things get going) to guide you and your team through the process and provide important event information.
- **Overall Timeline:**

  - **February 19** Start fundraising
  - **March 14** \$750 due per team
  - **March 21** \$1,000 due per team
  - **April 5** \$1,250 due per team & **Free Throw for Kids Event** at Lakota West High School
